



## **Professor Aikawa Young Investigator Prize**

### **Purpose**

The Prize was established to promote the activities of the International Society for Burn Injuries (ISBI) by encouraging and motivating young ISBI members from a developing country to conduct research on clinical problems and prevention of burns.

### **The Award**

#### **A total of six investigators will be awarded:**

- The Gold Prize, Physician Category: US\$2,000.00 and the Certificate (or a Medal)
- The Gold Prize, Non-Physician Category: US\$2,000.00 and the Certificate (or a Medal)
- The Silver Prize, Physician Category: US\$ 1,000.00 and the Certificate (or a Medal)
- The Silver Prize, Non-Physician Category: US\$1,000.00 and the Certificate (or a Medal)
- The Bronze Prize, Physician Category: US\$ 500.00 and the Certificate (or a Medal)
- The Bronze Prize, Non-Physician Category: US\$ 500.00 and the Certificate (or a Medal)

**\*\*\* Physician submissions must be for oral presentations. Non physician submissions may be either oral or poster submissions.**

### **Eligibility**

1. Applicant must be a paid-up ISBI member from a developing country as defined by the ISBI dues category of "low" income areas.
2. Applicant must be under the age of 40 years on the opening day of the biennial ISBI Congress.
3. Applicant must be the first author of the paper presented during the biennial ISBI Congress when Prize is given.

### **Application**

The applicant must specify the desire to be considered by indicating so on the abstract submission form. The applicant must also send a notification of abstract submission including abstract title, a **Conflict of Interest statement including grants, travel expenses and registration fees**, and a copy of your Curriculum Vitae (CV). ### **Selection**

Accepted abstracts will be assigned to a designated session so that the committee members and the session moderator(s) can evaluate the presentations. If there is only one session, it will be scheduled Monday, 29 August 2016. If a second session is deemed necessary due to a large number of accepted abstracts, the second session will be scheduled for Tuesday, 30 August 2016. Final prize recipients will be decided by an appropriate ISBI committee.

Prizes will be awarded during the General Assembly.
